Learners aged 16+

The Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Apprenticeship framework is popular with employers in England with 8,149 Level 2 and Level 3 apprentices starting training in 2011/12. The Vehicle Maintenance & Repair framework is supported by a wide range of employers of all sizes (micro, small/medium and large) across the sector including Jaguar Land Rover, Honda, Mercedes Benz, Toyota, Ford and BMW.

Intermediate Level (Level 2) apprentices will train as Service Technicians/Technicians, learning how to test and repair a range of vehicles. Progression to Level 3 (Advanced Level Apprenticeship) is available to suitable apprentices.

Apprentices learn on the job and attend Appleby Training and Heritage Centre one day each week to improve their skills and knowledge and acquire the formal qualifications which are required to complete the framework.

Typically it takes between 12 and 24 months to complete this
